DAFilms.com brings a new documentary project to the Czech Republic - My Street

Founded in 2011 in London, the unique documentary project My Street Films finds its way outside the UK for the first time thanks to the DAFilms.com portal. Having struck all of London, the film fever has come to the streets of Prague in the middle of May 2014. "My Street is a kind of citizen journalism," says founder of the project and director of Open City Docs Fest Michael Stewart. "It is all about exploring the boundaries of documentary, which are shifting all the time." Join the amateur and professional filmmakers who have decided to grab their video cameras, cameras and mobile phones and show us where and how they live. It may be you who will go to London with your winning film...



Do you have an idea for a film about your place but are not sure if you can treat it?

My Street Films opens up the first option to join the project and help create a film map of short documentary stories. More specifically, it starts a subject competition; subjects up to 300 words can be sent by June 8, 2014 to info@mystreetfilms.cz. The authors of selected subjects will have a chance to film them with the support of professional documentarists. All you have to do then is submit your film to www.mystreetfilms.cz by September 7, watch films by others, enjoy the rich variety of related events and wait for the announcement of the winners who will take their films to Open <u>City Docs Fest</u> in London or <u>Jihlava IDFF</u>.



Several films have been added to the My Street Films map. Besides the project's <u>trailer</u> made by talented director <u>Petr</u> Hátle, the first film submitted by one of our tutors is a documentary by Bohdan Bláhovec. He has contributed with his film My Home capturing one afternoon in Dejvice quarter. He has described his film as "an encounter of innocence and inebriation on a few square metres".

You can look forward to the inspiring films by other filmmakers in the course of the summer! Are there similar secret or, on the contrary, visible stories around you as well? Film them and
